



LONSDALE PARK: INFO SHEET

1. ESSENTIAL ITEMS TO BRING TO CAMP

- First Aid Kit + a current certified First Aider must be present with the group throughout the stay
- Toilet Paper
- Tea towels, Dishwashing Liquid and cleaning cloths
- Rubbish Bags
- Linen, bedding and pillows
- Tomahawk, axe, lighter (if using fire pit or barbeque).

2. YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES WHILE USING THE CAMP

- Cleaning of the facilities and grounds to a satisfactory standard at the end of your stay.
- Report any breakages, damages or faults to the caretaker.
- The removal of all rubbish and recycling from park. Caretaker can provide buckets for food scraps if necessary.
- To keep an accurate account of the total number of adults and children staying each night.
- Adult supervision of 1:6 children and young persons while using park activities.
- Please contact the caretaker 24-48 hours before arrival to arrange opening of the facilities.

3. THE PARK PROVIDES THE FOLLOWING:

- Mops, brooms, squeegees, buckets, cleaning products for the floors & surfaces
- Hi -Viz vests (to use while walking along roadside to hike), blindfolds, compasses, planks (team building activities)
- Coin-operated (\$1 coins only) washing machine and drier
- Fully equipped kitchen; fridge, freezer, stoves, pots, pans, crockery, cutlery, utensils, dishwasher, zip hot water heater, toaster, food processor, microwave.
- Fire pit and wood-fuelled barbeque; wood provided. Fires are dependent on local fire regulations, please check with caretaker.
- A pull-down projector screen in main hall with suitable power socket connection.

- Tables and chairs with enough seating for 80 people.

4. MISCELLANEOUS

Nearest medical centres are Whangaroa Health Services 09 4050541 (15min drive north) and Broadway Health Waipapa 09 4017172 (15 min drive south)

Nearest convenience store is Kaeo Four Square (10 min drive north) or New World and Countdown supermarkets in Kerikeri (20min drive south)

There is a phone in the main hall (09 4050189) for local calls only.

All lodges have adjoining toilets and showers.

5. OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES AVAILABLE

- Commando Course
- Team Building Activities
- Blind Fold Course
- Confidence Course
- Bush Activity Trial
- Hiking Trail : Caretaker must be notified of date and time hike will be used.

6. PRIVATE BOOKINGS

- Alcohol is permitted, however it must only be consumed in the Hall, Kitchen and around outside barbeque area.
- No alcohol or smoking is allowed around the park activities, in the bush area or in the lodges.
- Extra attention must be made during clean-up to ensure all bottle tops and smoke butts have been removed from the grounds.
